A lifetime Hawaiian musician from Palolo Valley on Oahu, Cruz serenaded four galas during President Obama's inauguration. Acclaimed by *Hawaii Magazine* as 2008's Best Singer Songwriter for his premiere CD, Cruz's second album, "One of These Days" hit #1 in Hawaii, #2 on the Billboard Heatseekers Chart for the Pacific Region and #6 on the Billboard World Chart and won the Na Hoku Hanohano Award for Contemporary Album of the Year.

John is the official spokesman for Sprint Hawaii's Mr. Holland's Opus Foundation which donates free ukuleles to school music programs in need. He visits classrooms and gives surprise performances to inspire kids to achieve and believe in themselves.

No stranger to the big screen, Cruz is the subject of the documentary film "Made of Music - The Story of John Cruz," which debuted at the Louis Vuitton Hawaii International Film Festival in Honolulu, and was honored with the Aloha Visionary Filmmaker Award at the Molokai Film Festival.
